If your child is late they MUST report of the Front Office on arrival. If a child is going to be absent for a period of time, there is a form that must be completed. This is a legal requirement. The form can be collected from the Front Office.

CANTEEN AND UNIFORM SHOP

St Patrick's School offers playgroup on Wednesday and Friday mornings from 9:30-11:30am. Playgroup is free. Families attending are asked to bring a piece of fruit for snack time. Visitors are asked to sign in via the IPAD in the Front Office.

ITALIAN AT ST PATRICK'S 2024

Dear Parents/ Caregivers

As you are all aware Italian will be the language taught at St Patrick's for this year. The children will be provided with a 1×40 -minute lesson a week.

It is anticipated that children who are exposed to a second language gain a greater understanding of a culture other than their own and gain greater awareness of what is meant by the term "multiculturalism".

Exposure to another language also:

- Enriches student's educational experiences.
- Helps children appreciate and respect their own culture and the culture of others.
- Helps children develop an interest and take pleasure in learning another language.
- Helps develop children's linguistic, cognitive and social development.
- Helps children develop greater personal confidence.
- Enhances children's understanding of the functions and structure of their own language.

My Learning Intentions for each child in all classes will be to:

• Expose them to the Italian language and culture.

- Cover basic grammar of the language.
- Speak in Italian through song, instruction, basic oral conversations and repetition.
- Read and write basic sentences in Italian according to each child's abilities.

Parents can support their children's learning by showing interest in what they are doing in class and encouraging them to take pride in their presentation of book work.






