Dear Parents/Caregivers,

MEET THE TEACHER

It was great to see so many parents come to our Meet the Teacher Evening. The evening started with a BBQ followed by a parent information evening about Numeracy and what this means for us at St Patrick's School. I was then able to share our 2023 Annual Improvement Plan and highlight our achievements. Parents were then able to visit classrooms and talk to their child's teacher. Numeracy will be a Curriculum focus for 2024.

SCHOOL BOARD

St Patrick's has a School Board consisting of the Parish Priest, School Staff and parents of the school. The Board allows parents to have a voice in the strategic direction of the school. The School Board meets twice each term. This year it will be in Week 3 and Week 8 of each term from 7.00 - 9.00pm. Board members hold their position for 2 years. We have some vacancies on the School Board. If you would like to join the School Board, please complete the Nomination Form in this Newsletter and return the form as a matter of urgency.

CHILDREN'S UNIVERSITY

Once again, we are offering our students the opportunity to be involved in Children's University. CUA aims to encourage high quality out of school hour's activities for children aged between 7 and 14 years of age, engaging with the wider community as learning partners in this process. The most important principle of CUA is that participation is voluntary, and activities must take place outside of the normal school day. If your child would like to become a member of CUA for 2024, please collect a form from the Front Office, complete the details and return it to school by 25th March along with payment.

MID YEAR RECEPTION ENROLMENTS

We still have vacancies for our Mid-Year Reception class. If you have a child or know of any family who has a child born between 1st May and 31st October, they are eligible to start Reception in July. Enrolment forms must be completed and handed into the Front Office. An interview time will be offered.

PUPIL FREE DAY - TERM 1

Our **Term 1 Pupil Free Day is booked for Friday 8th March**. Please put this date in your diary. We ask that you make childcare arrangements for this day. **There are NO STUDENTS at the school on this day**. Our OSHC service will be available.

NAPLAN

The National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) will once again take place in Term 1. All students in Years 3 and 5 will be sitting the assessments between 13 March to 25 March. A practice test will take place on 27 February. NAPLAN provides additional professional judgements about a student's attainment of literacy and numeracy and do not replace the extensive, ongoing assessments made by the school staff.

STUDENT WELLBEING

Student Wellbeing is always a focus at St Patrick's School. Each year, we build on our previous Professional Learning to make our school a safe place for students. This year, we are involved in a Catholic Education system approach and will be part of PBIS Professional learning. PBIS stands for *Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports*. It's a set of practices for improving student behavior and school culture by setting clear behavioral expectations, teaching students how to meet those expectations, and supporting them in this process based on their needs. Alongside this, teachers continue to embed Zones of Regulation into their classroom practice. *Zones of Regulation* allow students to understand where their emotions are and use strategies taught to reach the optimal zone for learning. This year, teachers are also introducing weekly lessons of Friendology 101 from the *UR Strong* Program. Research shows that relationships are the heart of wellbeing & learning. When we get friendships right in schools, children flourish! Parents are able to access the

parent portal of UR Strong for free. This portal has many useful ideas that can support your children. Students who require more individualised support can access the services of our School Chaplain (Monday) or Counsellor (Thursday).







AMBULANCE COVER

Ambulance cover

The school has ambulance cover for students who have accidents here at school or while on a school organised event. However, this cover does not include students with a pre-existing condition such as asthma and anaphylaxis or reactions to allergies.

We will ring an ambulance if we need support in administering first aid, however in the case of students with pre-existing conditions the parents will be charged by Ambulance SA for their service.

This can cost upward of \$900 so we strongly encourage you to take out ambulance cover, particularly

Hello and welcome to all our new families and a welcome back to our existing families.

I am currently in the process of issuing a school fee statement to all families and this will take place in the next couple of weeks. I will place a statement in the eldest child's school bag so please watch for this.

We offer direct debit, BPay, EFTPOS and also direct deductions from Centrelink payments to cater to the changing financial needs of our families at St Patrick's School. When the direct debit payment option is selected your school fee payment is calculated over the full school year right up until the 31st of December 2023. This means smaller payments are required, making this method the most affordable way to budget for your commitment. Please come into the office or ring me on 83034500 if one of these options would better suit your financial requirements.

School Card 2024 is applied for online. Instructions on how to do this are available at the front office. Please be aware School Card must be applied for each year.

Kính thưa quý phụ huynh/ Giám Hộ,

Thật vui khi thấy rất nhiều phụ huynh đến tham dự buổi tối Gặp gỡ Giáo viên. Buổi tối bắt đầu bằng bữa BBQ, sau đó là buổi tối thông tin dành cho phụ huynh về Toán và vai trò của môn Toán đối với chúng tôi tại Trường St Patrick. Sau đó, tôi chia sẽ Kế hoạch của năm 2023 và nêu bật những thành tựu của chúng ta. Sau đó, phụ huynh đến thăm lớp học và nói chuyện với giáo viên của con mình. Toán học sẽ là trọng tâm của chương trình giảng dạy vào năm 2024.

St Patrick's có Hội đồng trường bao gồm Cha xứ, Nhân viên nhà trường và phụ huynh. Hội đồng Nhà Trường cho phụ huynh có thể đóng góp về hướng đi của nhà trường. Một lần nữa, chúng tôi tạo cơ hội cho các em học sinh tham gia vào chuong? trình Đại học cho thiếu niên. (CUA) nhằm mục đích khuyến khích các hoạt động ngoài giờ học có với phẩm chất cao cho trẻ em từ 7 đến 14 tuổi, nhằm thu hút sự tham gia của cộng đồng rộng lớn hơn với tư cách là đối tác học tập. Nguyên tắc quan trọng nhất để tham gia vào CUA là tự nguyện và các hoạt động được diễn ra ngoài giờ học bình thường. Nếu con em quý vị muốn tham gia học chương trình của CUA năm 2024, xin vui lòng lấy mẫu đơn từ Văn phòng, điển thông tin chi tiết và gửi lại cho nhà trường trước ngày 25 tháng 3 cùng với khoản tiền thanh toán chi phí.

Chúng tôi vẫn còn chỗ trống cho lớp Khai giảng giữa năm. Nếu quý vị có con em hoặc biết bất kỳ gia đình nào có con em sinh từ ngày 1 tháng 5 đến ngày 31 tháng 10, các em có đủ điều kiện đề bắt đầu Lớp Mẫu Giáo vào tháng Bảy. Cần phải điền đơn ghi danh và nộp lại cho Văn phòng. Sẽ có buổi phỏng vấn.Ngày nghỉ học kỳ 1 của chúng ta sẽ vào thứ Sáu, ngày 8 tháng 3. Xin vui lòng ghi ngày này vào nhật ký của quý vị. Xin quý vị sắp xếp việc trông chừng con em trong ngày này. Dịch vụ OSHC (chăm sóc ngoài giờ) của trường sắn sảng để sử dụng.

Chương trình Đánh giá Quốc gia - Đọc viết và Số học (NAPLAN) sẽ diễn ra trong Học kỳ 1. Tắt cả học sinh Lớp 3 và Lớp 5 sẽ thực hiện các bài đánh giá từ ngày 13 tháng 3 đến ngày 25 tháng 3. Bài kiểm tra thực hành sẽ vào ngày 27 tháng 2. NAPLAN cung cấp các đánh giá chuyên môn bổ sung về trình độ đọc viết, toán số của học sinh và không thay thế các đánh giá mở rộng, thuồng xuyên do nhân viên nhà trường thực hiện. Phúc lọi học sinh luôn là trọng tâm tại Trường St Patrick. Hàng năm, chúng tôi để ra chương trình Học tập Chuyên môn để giúp trường học của chúng ta thành một nơi an toàn cho các em học sinh.

Năm nay, chúng tôi tham gia vào cách tiếp cận hệ thống Giáo dục Công giáo và sẽ là một phần của chương trình học tập Chuyên môn của PBIS. PBIS là viết tắt của Can thiệp và hỗ trợ hành vi tích cực. Đó là một tập hợp các biện pháp thực hành nhằm cải thiện hành vi của học sinh và văn hóa trường học bằng cách đặt ra những kỳ vọng rõ ràng về hành vi, dạy cho học sinh cách đáp ứng những yêu cầu đó và hỗ trợ các em trong quá trình này dựa trên nhu cầu của các em. Bên cạnh đó, giáo viên tiếp tục đưa các lãnh vực quy định vào thực hành với các lớp của mình. Lãnh vực quy định học sinh hiều cảm xúc mình ở đâu và sử dụng các chiến lược học hỏi đề đạt kết quả cao nhất cho việc học. Năm nay, các giáo viên cũng giới thiệu bài học hàng tuần về Friendology 101 của Chương trình UR Strong.

Nghiên cứu cho thấy mối quan hệ là trung tâm của hạnh phúc và học tập. Khi chúng ta có được tình bạn đúng nghĩa ở trường học, các em phát triển mạnh mẽ! Phụ huynh có thể truy cập miễn phí cổng thông tin dành cho phụ huynh từ UR Strong. Cổng thông tin này có nhiều ý tưởng hữu ích có thể hỗ trợ con em quý vị.
