NAPLAN

All Year 3 and 5 students took part in a NAPLAN practice test last week. This was important to ensure that devices worked correctly for students and that students felt comfortable in navigating the online platform. Teachers will be able to provide students with further practice tests in the next couple of weeks. NAPLAN test will begin on the 13th March and conclude on the 25th March.

ST PATRICK'S CELEBRATES 60 YEARS

This year, St Patrick's School celebrates 60 years. We will be having several celebrations throughout the year to mark this important milestone. The school was officially opened on 15th March 1964. As Sunday 17th March is **St Patrick's Day**, it is customary for us to celebrate our feast day. We will do this on Friday 15th March with a prayer service at 9:00am and a launch of our birthday celebrations. All parents are warmly invited to attend this celebration.

HARMONY WEEK

18 -24 March is Harmony Week, a celebration that recognises our diversity and brings together Australians from all different backgrounds. It's about inclusiveness, respect and a sense of belonging for everyone. At St Patrick's School, we take every opportunity to celebrate our rich cultural heritage and diversity. On Friday 22nd March, we will celebrate Harmony Day at 9:30 am with a parade followed by a prayer service at 10:00am. There will be a morning tea for parents from 8:45am until the parade. Andrew Chinn, a wonderful musician and engaging educator will then conduct workshops between recess and lunch for all classes and a school concert after lunch. We invite parents to this celebration. This is an event that many parents make time to attend, and we hope that once again, parents will put this date in their diary. Students and parents are asked to come dressed in their national dress or alternatively wear something orange.

STUDENT SAFETY

Many students walk home or are given permission by parents to walk to the local library. Teaching students independence is a lifelong skill. Student safety is crucial, and we ask that parents speak to their child(ren) in regard to this. The following points may help you.

"Students and families are reminded to be wary of approaches from strangers, especially when they are unaccompanied or travelling to and from school. If they are approached students should not respond and should not accept offers of rides or gifts.

Students should seek the assistance of other nearby adults if they feel unsafe and should report the event to a trusted adult (parent or school staff member) as soon as possible.

SAPOL advises that taking out a mobile phone and calling police can deter the offender and they recommend the student making a formal report to their closest police station."

NAPLAN REMINDER!

A friendly reminder that our Year 3 and Year 5 students will participate in the NAPLAN tests consisting of reading, writing, language conventions and numeracy assessments from Wednesday the 13th of March until Monday the 25th of March.

Year 5's will complete all their assessments online. Year 3 students will complete a paper writing assessment; however, all other tests will be online.

Students have had an opportunity to become familiar with the test format and their teachers have supported them through using the school technologies.

Some nervousness is expected and as a parent, you can treat the NAPLAN testing days just like any other school day.

Please remember that the NAPLAN assessments provide a snapshot of your child's progress; it is just another way of finding out what students are able to do.

SIX WAYS YOU CAN HELP YOUR CHILD AT SCHOOL

At St Patrick's we have had a long history of a strong partnership between home and school. In fact, next week we begin to celebrate **60 years** of that partnership!

We believe that your support in educating your child is essential for your child's success as both a learner and as person. With this in mind, I write to you on behalf of our teaching staff and school Leadership to remind you of some of the ways you can help bring out the best in your child as a student at St Patrick's School. Here are six ways you can help your child at school.



Parental Involvement

Organisation:

- 1. Help your child be organised and ready for school each day.**
Being ready for school each day means that a child comes to school less anxious and ready to learn. This includes having all the equipment they need for the day.
- 2. Whenever you can, encourage your child to read nightly and undertake social learning outside of school hours.**
Regular literacy and numeracy practise relative to the child's age and needs, is a way parents can support their child's learning. Cultural learning is equally important in developing a child's identity.
- 3. Ensure that your child arrives to school on time. That is, before 9.50am.**
This means your child will begin the day with the rest of the class and will not miss out on vital instruction by the teacher to prepare them for the day.
- 4. Ensure that your child attends school regularly.**
Over the course of a child's 13 years at school, regular absenteeism can have serious impact on a child's learning, especially in the primary years when fundamental learning takes place. We encourage families to keep to a minimum the amount of time your child is absent from school.
- 5. Avoid picking up your child early from school unless it is absolutely essential.**
*This, like being late to school, reduces the amount of time your child spends in quality learning time. Just missing 10 minutes of school each day over the course of a year, a child can miss out on over a week of school. We especially remind families that collecting children early during school events like **school assemblies**, impacts on a child's connection with school and their peers. These events are an essential part of learning to respect and value the work and efforts of other children.*
- 6. Join our community events that celebrate children and their learning as opportunities arise.**
Children love to see their parents at school. This shows that you value their learning and their school. Events like our recent 'Meet the Teacher' evening was a great example of community involvement in your child's school.

An Invitation

You are invited to join the St. Patrick's School Board

Our School Board is an advisory body of volunteers who work together to provide ideas and opinions to help the Principal and the School Board make the school a better place for our children's learning.

The School Board needs to represent the diversity of the School community, which includes the parents and caregivers of the students in our School. It gives our School representative the opportunity to discuss educational and general issues and respond to a variety of needs by providing information to parents and community members, getting feedback for them and presenting their views to the School and School Board.

Participation means attending a meeting twice a term from 7.00pm—9.00pm and contributing to the discussions and decisions.

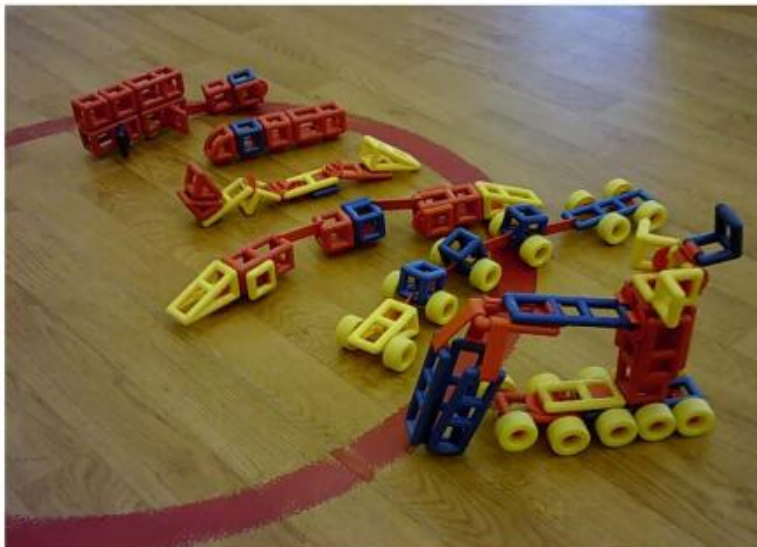

AMBULANCE COVER

Ambulance cover

The school has ambulance cover for students who have accidents here at school or while on a school organised event. However, this cover does not include students with a pre-existing condition such as asthma and anaphylaxis or reactions to allergies.

We will ring an ambulance if we need support in administering first aid, however in the case of students with pre-existing conditions the parents will be charged by Ambulance SA for their service.

This can cost upward of \$900 so we strongly encourage you to take out ambulance cover, particularly

if your child has a pre-existing health condition.

FROM THE FINANCE OFFICER

School Fees 2024

A friendly reminder to those families, who do not have a direct debit set up, that Term 1 school fees are due by the last day of Term 1 the 12/4/24.

We offer direct debit, BPay, EFTPOS and also direct deductions from Centrelink payments to cater to the changing financial needs of our families at St Patrick's School. When the direct debit payment option is selected your school fee payment is calculated over the full school year right up until the 31st of December 2024. This means smaller payments are required, making this method the most affordable way to budget for your commitment. 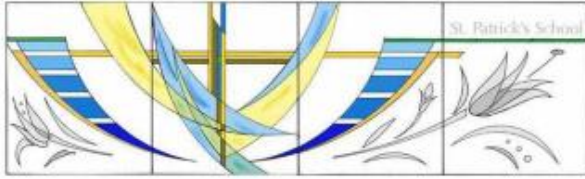
School Card 2024 must be applied for online each year and the instructions are in this newsletter. If you have any problems please come and see me if you are having any issues.
